PARIS

*The Paris visit will include tours of the major sites, museums, and monuments of Paris, a bike tour, guided tours of key historical neighborhoods with a focus on World War II, and a farewell cruise on the Seine.

NORMANDY

*The Normandy visit, with a D-Day expert as a guide, will include student workshops at the Memorial Museum in Caen, visits to the landing beaches, invasion sites, museums and area cemeteries, and the town of Bayeux. A more detailed itinerary will be available in November.

The \$2500.00 all-inclusive tuition will cover: all round trip transportation from and to GA, hotels, meals, cancellation and foreign medical insurance, study programs, admissions, guides, tips, and special events.

Space is limited and offered on a first come, first served basis. A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is due to Paris for Teens by October 15, 2003, and the \$2000.00 balance is due by December 1st.
